JUDGING ASSIGNMENTS

Conformation

- All Licensed Classes, including Licensed Altered Classes, will be offered for all recognized eligible breeds in the following groups: Guardian Dog, Scenthound, Sighthound & Pariah Dog, Gun Dog, Northern Breed, Herding Dog (except BSD), Terrier and Companion Dog.
- Group and Best In Multi-Breed Show Judges will be made public immediately prior to the start of judging for these classes.
- Order of Judging: When feasible, judging of breeds will be alphabetical within each group. Group judging to commence immediately following all breed judging in that group, or at the discretion of the Event Committee.

Agility, Obedience and Rally Obedience

- Order of classes and trials are at the Event Committees discretion. For example, Agility may be judged in this order: AG1 T1, AG1 T2, AG2 T1, AG2 T2, AG3 T1, AG3 T2.
- Agility, Obedience and Rally Obedience have entry limits and no wait lists will be established. Please see the *UKC LICENSED & Non-Licensed CLASSES OFFERED* section of this Premium List for details.
- Agility ring flooring.** *The Great Hall agility ring flooring will be covered with artificial turf to better accommodate the agility exhibitors.*

Terrier Race

ENTRY INFORMATION

Pre-Entry and Day of Show Entry offered

• ELIGIBILITY

- Dogs must be permanently registered with UKC, have a Temporary Listing (TL) number, or have a Limited Privilege (LP) listing number by the closing date and time in order to enter. No excep-

- tions will be made. Entries for ineligible dogs will be returned.
- Dogs must meet the eligibility requirements for the activity which they are entering. For requirements, refer to the appropriate activity rules and regulations.
- An unentered dog may not be substituted for an entered dog.

• **ENTRY INFORMATION, FEES and TIME**

1. **Total Dog is offered on Friday, October 28, 2011.** See page ③ of this Premium List for complete details.

2. **Entry Fees and Time (deadline):**

a. **PRE-ENTRY.**

1.) **Pre-Entry Fee**

- \$20 first entry. \$15 each additional entry (same day, same dog, same event) made at the same time.
- Additional entry made at a later time will be charged first entry fee. No charge for Non-licensed classes and Conformation-Junior Showmanship.

Pre Entry Specials

- Conformation - \$75 same dog all 6 shows.
- Performance (Agility, Obedience and/or Rally Obedience) any 6 runs (single activity or combination) - \$75 same dog.

2.) **Pre-Entry Deadline:** Pre-Entries entries will be accepted at United Kennel Club until Wednesday, October 12, 2011, at 4:30 p.m. Eastern Time. NO Pre-Entries will be accepted or processed by UKC after that time. Entries received after the Pre-Entry deadline date will be held and will be charged Day-of-Show fees. NO EXCEPTIONS.

b. **PRE-ENTRY ONLY.** Terrier Races are PE only. Entry deadline is the same as the Pre-Entry Deadline.

c. **DAY OF SHOW.**

1.) Entry Fee: \$25 first entry, \$20 each additional entry, same day, same dog, same event, made at the same time.

2.) **Day-of-Show Entry Times:**

a. Friday: 7:30 a.m. – 8:30 a.m.

b. Saturday and Sunday: 7:00 - 8:00 a.m.

c. **Conformation-Junior Showmanship:** – no charge.

3. **PLEASE NOTE: additional closing information for Performance Events (Agility, Obedience and Rally Obedience).** Performance Events Pre-Entries or Day of Show entries will close in accordance with the information above **OR** when numerical limit for the activity (Trial) has been reached, after which time entries shall not be accepted, substituted, cancelled or altered (except as noted in the refund section of this Premium List.) No wait lists will be established. No exceptions will be made. Entries received after that time will not be accepted.

4. Each dog must be entered on a separate entry form.

5. No conditional entries will be accepted.

6. Due to the large volume of pre-entries coming in at the last minute, any entry missing crucial information or any fax entry missing authorization for us to use your credit card for entry fees may not be contacted and will not be processed.

• **SUBMITTING ENTRIES**

1. Gateway Nationals entries may be submitted on the Official Gateway Nationals UKC Entry form included with this Premium List or on any current official UKC entry from (<http://www.ukcdogs.com/res/pdf/fo1fbl.pdf>). Photocopies of these forms may be used as well. Entries may also be submitted online on the UKC official website: www.ukcdogs.com.

2. **Entries may be submitted**

a. **On-line.** Pre-Entries may be submitted online at www.ukcdogs.com, click on the Gateway Nationals logo.

b. **Mailed.** Mailed Entries must include fees. Mailed entries received without fees will not be accepted.

c. **Faxed.** Fax entries to 269-349-5590. Faxed entries must be accompanied by a cover sheet stating the number of pages, what shows and how many dogs per show. Visa/Master Card number and expiration date, as well as the printed cardholder's name and address must be included on the entry form. A faxed entry must be received in UKC's offices by the closing date and time of pre-entries and must be fully legible and complete in order for it to be accepted. We will not accept a faxed entry after the closing date and time based on a "Transmission OK" message in the possession of the owner; no exceptions. Faxed entry received after the closing date and time of pre-entries will be charged the Day-of-Show entry fee. No exceptions.

d. **Hand-delivered.** Hand-delivered to the United Kennel Club office at 100 E Kilgore Rd, Kalamazoo MI 49002-5584.

• **PAYMENT FOR ENTRIES**

1. Payment (pre-entry and day of show) must be made by cash, check, money order, MasterCard or Visa. No entry will be accepted without full payment.

2. Make checks and money orders payable to "United Kennel Club, Inc." Checks and money orders must be payable in U.S. funds.

3. When paying by MasterCard or Visa, entry must include the card number and expiration date, as well as the printed cardholder's name, address, daytime phone, and signature. Fax numbers and e-mail addresses should be included, when applicable.

4. Post-dated checks, returned checks and declined credit or debit cards do not constitute valid entry fees. UKC will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check or money order. Exhibitors who repeatedly submit invalid entry fees may be put on a CASH ONLY basis.

• **ENTRY CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS**

1. Entry cancellations or substitutions **MUST** be received in writing prior to the closing of Pre-Entries or the closing of the activity, and **MUST** include the dog's UKC number, breed and name. Cancellations or substitutions received by telephone are **NOT** acceptable. Substitutions require a new completed entry form.

2. No refund of entry fees will be made for entries cancelled after the Pre-Entry deadline, except in the cases of bitches that come into season and are entered in "Agility, Obedience, Rally Obedience and/or Terrier Race," events. In those cases, refunds may be obtained by providing the superintendent with a veterinarian's certificate verifying that the bitch came into season after the closing date. The certificate may be mailed, provided the postmark is no later than the date prior to the day of the trial, or delivered by hand to the UKC Superintendent personnel before the start of the trials.

3. Cancelled or substituted entries submitted before the activity close of entries will be charged a \$10 processing fee. No entries will be refunded after the activity is closed.

4. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee.

5. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries before processing. If a duplicate entry is processed, however, no refund will be made.

6. Entry overpayments may be donated to the general trophy fund and will not be refunded.

7. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the host organization it is impossible to open or to complete a show or trial, no refund of entry fee will be made.

8. If, in the opinion of the host club, the well being of dogs, exhibitors or spectators is at risk due to extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, or extreme heat, the host club may cancel or stop a show or trial before completion. No refunds will be made in such cases.

• **ENTRY CONFIRMATION, ARMBANDS AND JUDGING PROGRAM**

- 1. Receipt of online entry.** Receipt of online entry will be acknowledged within three business days, but this does not constitute acceptance or confirmation of the entry.
- 2. E-mail confirmation of processed entry.** E-mail confirmation of entries will be made to the e-mail address included on the entry form as soon as practicable after the entry has been accepted and processed. Please verify the classes/events your dog is entered into when receiving this e-mail of processed entry. Should there be any errors please contact UKC Dog Events Department at e-mail: classic@ukcdogs.com or 269-343-9020 immediately.
- 3. Written confirmation.** Written confirmation of entries will be made by U.S. Postal mail as soon as practicable after the closing date of Pre-Entries. One armband will be assigned to each dog for all shows/trials in which the dog is entered for the weekend. Armbands will be mailed with the Gateway Nationals Judging Program. Entry confirmation information will be printed on the back of the Armband. Please verify the classes/events your dog is entered into when receiving this written confirmation of entry. Should there be any errors please contact UKC Dog Events Department at e-mail: classic@ukcdogs.com or 269-343-9020 immediately. If you do not receive your confirmation by the Saturday preceding these events, please notify UKC.
- 4.** A duplicate set of armbands will be available at the superintendent's desk.

• **CLASS CHANGE/CORRECTION OF ENTRY**

- 1.** Owners are responsible for the accuracy of information in the entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors. Owners and exhibitors are responsible for correcting any errors in their entry.
- 2.** Dogs that, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a title after the closing of entries, may be transferred from the entered class to another class for which the dog is now eligible, provided that a request for transfer is made in writing to UKC not later than one-half hour prior to the start of any regular judging at the show.
- 3.** All other corrections to entries must be made in writing to the Event Secretary not later than one-half hour prior to the start of any regular judging at the show.

FRIDAY

1. Conformation.

- a. Junior Showmanship.** Show 1: 8:30 a.m., immediately followed by Junior Showmanship Show 2.
- b. Breed Judging.** Shows 1 & 2 to follow the judging of Junior Showmanship, or 9 a.m. whichever comes first or at the discretion of the Event Committee.
- c. Group Judging.** Group judging to commence immediately following all breeds in that group, or at the discretion of the Event Committee.

- 2. Agility, Obedience and Rally Obedience Trials.** Trial 1: 8 a.m. Trial 2 to follow Trial 1; however, the order of classes and trials are at the Event Committees discretion. For example, Agility may be judged in this order: AG1 T1, AG1 T2, AG2 T1, AG2 T2, AG3 T1, AG3 T2.

- 3. Terrier Racing.** Not to be held before 9 a.m. A more specific time to be announced in the Judging Program.

SATURDAY & SUNDAY

1. Conformation.

- a. Junior Showmanship.** Show 1: 8 a.m., immediately followed by Junior Showmanship Show 2.

- b. Breed Judging.** Show 1 & 2 to follow the judging of Junior Showmanship, or 8:30 a.m. whichever comes first, or at the discretion of the Event Committee.

- c. Group Judging.** Group judging to commence immediately following all breeds in that group, or at the discretion of the Event Committee.

- 2. Agility, Obedience and Rally Obedience Trials.** Trial 1: 8:00 a.m. Trial 2 to follow Trial 1; however, the order of classes and trials are at the Event Committees discretion. For example, Agility may be judged in this order: AG1 T1, AG1 T2, AG2 T1, AG2 T2, AG3 T1, AG3 T2.
- 3. Terrier Racing.** Morning run if possible. A more specific time to be announced in the Judging Program.

1. Licensed Classes.

- a.** Regular and Altered Licensed Classes will be offered for all eligible breeds minus Belgian Shepherd Dogs.

- a.** Group Competition, Best In Multi-Breed Show, Reserve Best In Multi-Breed Show.
- b.** Altered Group Competition, Altered Best In Multi-Breed Show, Altered Reserve Best In Multi-Breed Show.

• **AGILITY TRIALS (Indoor, Great Hall)**

- 1. Six Trials offered.** Two trials each day – Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

- 2. Entry Limit.** Entries limited to 150 entries per Judge per day. No wait list will be established.

- 3. Licensed Classes.** All licensed classes offered.

- 4. Ring flooring.** *The Great Hall agility ring flooring will be covered with artificial turf to better accommodate the agility exhibitors.*

• **OBEDIENCE TRIALS (Indoor, Great Hall)**

- 1. Two Trials Offered.** One trial each day – Friday and Saturday.

- 2. Entry Limit.** Entries limited to 20 entries per day. No wait list will be established.

- 3. Licensed Classes.** All licensed classes offered.

• **RALLY OBEDIENCE TRIALS (Indoor, Great Hall)**

- 1. Six Trials Offered.** Two trials each day – Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

- 2. Entry Limit.** Entries limited to 75 entries per Judge per day. No wait list will be established.

- 3. Licensed Classes.** All licensed classes offered.

• **TERRIER RACES (Outdoor) (Note: Pre-Entry Only)**

- 1. Four Races offered.** Two races on Friday, one on each Saturday and Sunday.

- 2. Entry Limit.** No entry limit.

- 3. Licensed Classes.** All Flat Racing and Steeplechase Classes.

****Please note substantial changes to Total Dog this year****

TOTAL DOG AWARD

To be eligible for a "Total Dog" award a dog must:

- 1.** On Friday, October 28, 2011, compete in conformation (*note: with Special Permission by the United Kennel Club the Belgian Shepherd Breed winners as judged in conformation at their Specialty on Saturday, October, 29, 2011, will be included in this special competition; however, the performance portion must be from a Friday performance event*) with competition and win one of the following classes: Best Male/Female of Variety, Best Male/Female, Best of Winners, Champion, Grand Champion, Best of Breed, Group 1 through 4 (Note:

Group 4 win only counts if there are five or more breeds in the Group class.), Best In Multi-Breed Show, or Reserve Best In Multi-Breed Show; with special permission from the United Kennel Club the following addition to the existing Total Dog Rules regarding conformation competition requirements for the Champion and Grand Champion classes shall apply solely on Friday, October 28, 2011.

a. Champion Classes. The following will be granted a competition win:

1. Champion Competition win.
2. Reserve Champion win with 3 or more dogs in competition.
3. Champion Award of Merit (CAOM) shall count toward competition win when computing a total dog qualifier. The number of Champion Awards of Merit to be awarded shall be calculated as follows:
 - 5-9 dogs in competition – 1 CAOM
 - 10-14 dogs in competition – 2 CAOM
 - 15-19 dogs in competition – 3 CAOM
 - 20-24 dogs in competition – 4 CAOM
 - 25-29 dogs in competition – 5 CAOM
 - 30-34 dogs in competition – 6 CAOM
 - 35-40 dogs in competition – 7 CAOM

b. Grand Champion Classes. Grand Award of Merits (GAOM) shall count towards competition when computing a total dog qualifier. The number of Grand Awards of Merit to be awarded shall be calculated as follows:

- 3-4 dogs in competition – 1 GAOM
- 5-9 dogs in competition – 2 GAOM
- 10-14 dogs in competition – 3 GAOM
- 15-19 dogs in competition – 4 GAOM
- 20-24 dogs in competition – 5 GAOM
- 25-29 dogs in competition – 6 GAOM
- 30-34 dogs in competition – 7 GAOM
- 35-40 dogs in competition – 8 GAOM.

AND,

On the same day earn a qualifying score in an agility trial, lure coursing-regular stakes only (hosted by *United Greyhound Club), obedience trial, rally obedience trail, terrier race, dock jumping (air dogs, hosted by *Ultimate Air Dogs) only on Friday, October 28, 2011. *Those participating must sign up at the dock jumping or lure coursing event using the appropriate form provided by UKC.

2. Dogs who meet the above requirements will automatically receive a special "Total Dog" award.

**Total Dog Participant Parade,
Announcement of Qualifiers,
Total Dog Groups and Total Dog
Best In Multi-Breed Show Competition.**

On Saturday, October 29, 2011, just prior to Saturday's Gateway National Best In Multi-Breed Show competition the following will take place (consult the Judging Program for changes in procedure, time or location):

1. A parade of "Total Dog" participants will kick-off this special recognition and competition. All Total Dog participants (dog AND handler teams) report for the parade of Total Dog participants.
2. Followed by the announcement of the Total Dog Qualifiers.
3. Next, all Total Dog qualifiers will immediately compete in Total Dog Groups. The Total Dog Groups are the standard eight group designations. Each dog that qualifies will compete in the group that its breed belongs to.
4. Lastly, the Total Dog Group One winners will proceed to the judging of the Gateway Nationals Total Dog Best In Multi-Breed Show competition. A 2011 Gateway Nationals Total Dog Best In Multi-Breed Show and 2011 Gateway Nationals Total Dog Reserve Best In Multi-Breed Show winners will be selected.

• SCHEDULING CONFLICTS FOR DOGS COMPETING IN MULTIPLE EVENTS

1. Exhibitors are responsible for being available for judging at the scheduled time.
2. Every possible effort will be made to accommodate exhibitors who have dogs entered in multiple events, but judges are not required to wait for dogs. Exhibitors are advised to notify stewards in all rings affected by the conflict so that judges may more easily work around any conflicts.
3. If an Agility, Obedience, Rally Obedience or other performance exhibitor misses a scheduled judging time, the judge has the discretion to allow that exhibitor to run at the end of the class when possible or mark the dog absent. The Judge's decision is final.

EVENT HOURS

Show/trial judging times will also be published in the Gateway Nationals Judging Program. Event hours are from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. unless otherwise stated in the Judging Program.

GENERAL BUILDING AND PARKING INFORMATION

1. Building will be open to exhibitors at 2 p.m. until 6 p.m. on Thursday, October 27, 2011.
2. On Friday, Saturday and Sunday, the building will open at 7 a.m. and will close at 9 p.m. each night. Overnight security is not provided and no dog(s) may be left in the building overnight.
3. All event location times are Central Time. All entry deadline times are Eastern Time.
4. Please follow the directions of the parking attendants to facilitate an orderly traffic flow through the unloading areas and in the parking areas. Vehicles are allowed a 15 minute unloading time-frame. Violators will be towed.
5. Empty grooming space may not be saved. First come, first served is the rule.
6. No rugs or ground cover mats are allowed on the grooming room floor.
7. There will be absolutely NO SMOKING in all buildings and designated areas.
8. NO powdering allowed.
9. Overnight parking for R.V.'s and camping registration available. For camping information, see the Camping Reservation form in this Premium List.

EXHIBITOR AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. All events are held under the Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc. By entering these shows/trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.
2. UKC, its agents and its employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators or by exhibitors and handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians. UKC is not responsible for loss, accidents or theft.
3. UKC encourages exhibitors to present their dogs with the least amount of grooming necessary to enable a Judge to properly compare each dog with the standard of its breed. Dogs should be clean, with nails cut to a length suitable for the dog to perform the work for which it was bred, and with clean teeth. The Judge's determination that this rule has been violated shall be final. UKC enforces rules against artificially altering pigment and coat color, coat texture, and surgical alterations as outlined in the UKC® Rules and Regulations.
4. THE OWNER OR DESIGNATED HANDLER of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. The host organization, event committee, and superintendent

dent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system, or stewards or runners for the purpose of locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

5. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
6. Please remember to turn off cell phones and/or pagers before entering rings.
7. No unentered dogs allowed on the event grounds. Note: no dogs less than 8 weeks of age may be present on the grounds of a UKC Licensed event.
8. Dogs are not to be left unattended when crated in soft mesh crates or on a grooming table. No dog may be left on a grooming table or in an unlatched or unzipped crate.
9. Except when being judged or when crated, dogs must be kept on leash.

In order that the bad conduct of a few exhibitors does not spoil it for the majority of responsible exhibitors, UKC will take strong disciplinary action against any offenders.
14. All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit the event are vested in United Kennel Club and its assignees. All persons and animal on the event grounds at any time while the shows are in progress do, by attending these shows, grant to the club the right to photograph, televise, videotape, audiotape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent.

And up); Altered Breeder/Handler (6 mos. and up, handled by breeder or member of breeder's family); Altered Champion; and Altered Grand Champion.
C. Junior Showmanship Classes. Consist of: Pee Wee (over 2 yrs., under 4 yrs.); Sub-Junior (4 yrs., under 8 yrs.); Novice Junior, Open Junior (8 yrs., under 13 yrs.); Novice Senior, Open Senior (13 yrs., under 18 yrs.)
